

Volunteer of Excellence Award for Working with Adults

The Volunteer of Excellence Award may be earned twice – once for service directly to girls and once for working with adults.

Adults receiving this award:

- Must be an active, registered adult member
- Must have successfully completed a term of service and all requirements, including appropriate training, for the position
- Must meet the criteria for the award

This award requires:

- A Nomination
- 1 Letter of Endorsement

Process: Nominator will complete the nomination form and secure the endorsement letter and submit both parts to the Service Unit Adult Awards Coordinator by March 15. The Service Unit Awards Committee will review all nominations and determine who receives the award.

Criteria: The volunteer's performance has gone beyond the expectations of the position and has supported the mission-delivery goals within the Service Unit in one or more of the following areas: Membership Development/Community Cultivation, Volunteer Relations and Support, Program, Leadership and Governance, Fund Development, and Support Service (such as IT).
