Scholarship Awards Available

Scholarships are available only to graduating Senior Girl Scouts who will attend an institute of higher learning. Scholarships are credited directly to the institute of higher learning.

Board of Director's Scholarship

In order to qualify for the Board of Directors scholarship, applicants must have been a girl member of GSHNC for the past five years and have received her Gold Award. She also must have actively participated in Girl Scout Service projects to improve her community and have demonstrated academic excellence.

Barbara Glazier Bernhardt Scholarship

The Barbara Glazier Bernhardt Scholarship was established in 1986 by Robert Bernhardt, honoring Barbara as past chair of the Board of Directors and as a lifelong Girl Scout. In order to qualify for this scholarship, applicants must have received her Gold Award, demonstrated academic excellence and actively participated in both Girl Scout and non-Girl Scout community activities.

Norma Cannon Scholarship

The Norma Cannon Scholarship was endowed in memory of Norma Cannon by her children. Ms. Cannon was a lifelong supporter of Girl Scouts and its mission to help girls develop their leadership potential. In order to qualify for this scholarship, girls must be a resident of Cabarrus County and have demonstrated academic excellence. Completion of the Girl Scout Gold Award is preferred, but not required.

The Harper Family Scholarship

The Harper Family Scholarship was endowed in honor of Bert Harper, Board President from 2001-2010, by several of her colleagues at Bank of America. To qualify for this scholarship, an applicant must have completed her Gold Award and demonstrated academic excellence and a commitment to community service.

Betty Lynn Lambert Scholarship

The Betty Lynn Lambert Scholarship was endowed in honor of Betty Lynn Lambert, Board President from 1993-2000, by her daughter, Katherine. To qualify for this scholarship, an applicant must have been a member of Girl Scouts for the past five years and have received her Gold Award. She must also have demonstrated academic excellence and a commitment to community service.

Robert W. Maitt, Jr. Memorial Scholarship

The Robert W. Maitt, Jr. Memorial Scholarship was endowed in memory of Bob Maitt by his wife, Michelle Maitt. Michelle is a member of the Girl Scout Council of Advisors and Ambassadors and a former Board member, as well as one of the founders of the

Carolina Girl Scout Foundation. To qualify for this scholarship, an applicant must have been an active Girl Scout member for at least four years and shown a strong commitment to community service. Applicants must also demonstrate financial need.

Marie McLucas Scholarship

The Marie McLucas Scholarship was endowed in honor of Marie McLucas by her employer, Primax Properties. Marie McLucas has served our council as Treasurer and Chair of the Finance and Fund Development Committees. In order to qualify for this scholarship, applicants must be a resident of Cabarrus County and have demonstrated academic excellence and strong involvement in both Girl Scouts and her community. Completion of the Girl Scout Gold Award is preferred, but not required.

Jenny Zartman Memorial Scholarship

The Jenny Zartman Memorial Scholarship was established in honor of Jenny Zartman in 2007. Jenny's life was tragically cut short in 2006 and this scholarship was established in her memory by her family and friends. In order to qualify for this scholarship, an applicant must have been awarded her Gold Award and demonstrated academic excellence and a commitment to community service.

Book Awards

Book Awards are presented to Gold Award recipients who have demonstrated academic excellence and a strong commitment to community service activities.

Application Procedures

- February 2011:** Applications are sent to all graduating Senior Girl Scouts. It is also available on the GSHNC website www.hngirlscouts.org.
- March 9, 2012:** **Application deadline.** Late applications will NOT be considered. Applications, references and a 250 word essay must be received by 5:00p.m. You may drop off or mail applications to:

- April 2012:** Top candidates will be interviewed and the recipients will be notified by **April 30.**
