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## **First Aid & CPR Certification and Reimbursement Guidelines**

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In *Safety-Wise* a first aider is required for specific activities.

In planning, troop leaders must first consult *Safety-Wise* for specific emergency procedures and first aid standards and guidelines for each activity.

First Aid/CPR verification is not kept on file at the Service Center. Leaders are responsible for keeping their certification records.

First Aid/CPR certification must be kept up to date as required by the sponsoring organization.

The CPR training must be adequate for the participants in the activity covered by the first-aider: for example, child CPR for children younger than eight and adult CPR for older girls.

**First Aid/CPR reimbursement is to be given on a need basis. It reimburses ½ the cost not to exceed \$30.00. Troops are encouraged to use troop funds for all or part of the fee. To request reimbursement complete the Adult Learning Opportunity Scholarship Request Form on the reverse side.**
