<b>Eagle Mills 1</b>	8	\$90	°Fully enclosed, heated, and air-conditioned cabins. Bunk beds have twin-size plastic-covered foam camp mattresses. No bedding is provided – please bring your own. °Each unit (Eagle Mills or Union Grove) has access to one bathhouse with three showers, three toilets, six sinks, plus a single separate bathroom with toilet, shower, and sink. °Screened-in shelters with kitchen, fireplace, and tables are available at each unit's cabin 1 (shared with cabins 1-3) and cabin 6 (shared with cabins 4-6). °Each kitchen has a refrigerator/freezer, sink, stove and oven, microwave, coffeemaker, and gas grill. No utensils, dishes, pots, pans, foil, soap, or other cooking supplies are provided. Please bring your own. °Ice machine available in Union Grove bathhouse. Washer/Dryer is NOT for rental group use. °Toilet paper, paper towels, and trash bags are provided. Campfire wood is provided for groups with correct training. Once you have read the information there, click on the calendar next to 'Dale Earnhardt Environmental Leadership Campus at Oak Springs', and choose ' <b>Overnight</b> ' from the drop-down menu on the left.  Select the first date of your rental, and set the 'Duration' below the calendar. Click 'Reserve' next to the area(s) you are planning to rent.  The next screen will ask you to log in to your Doubleknot account or create a new one. Once you have done so, continue adding to your reservation until you have everything you need. Press 'Checkout' to complete your rental info and pay!

Firewood is provided for group use.

### Day-Only Rentals (9am – 7pm)

<b>Environmental Center</b>	\$300	Heated and air conditioned building with two bathrooms, environmental display room, and meeting room with seating for up to 30. Includes screen (projector rental is separate), wifi, and access to environmental education equipment – contact for more details if needed.	Follow the previous directions, but select ' <b>Day Use Only</b> ' from the drop-down menu, and set your Duration to how many days you need the facility for.
<b>Fields and Open Areas</b>	\$150	If you need <u>exclusive</u> use of fields in camp (Tent Camping areas, Sports fields, and various other communal fields, but NOT including Tarheelia Fire Circle, etc.), reserve this. Includes access to either port-a-potty(s) or single bathroom, depending on group size, special needs, and other rentals.	

## Outdoor Pavilion and Kitchen (Noon to Noon)

Name	Price	Notes	How to Reserve
<b>Outdoor Pavilion <u>WITHOUT</u> Kitchen</b>	\$375	Includes access to covered dining pavilion with seating for ~250, sink for water refills, handwashing station, and bathrooms – one large with three toilets and two sinks, and one single bathroom. Ice machine, all kitchen and serving equipment, and refrigerators/freezers are for rentals <b>with</b> kitchen ONLY. There is a refrigerator/freezer in the luggage shelter at bottom of the hill, and an ice machine in Union Grove for non-kitchen rental use. Bring all your own serving and dining equipment if you are planning to serve food using just the Pavilion.	Follow the rental directions from the first page, but select <b>'Outdoor Pavilion and Kitchen'</b> from the drop-down menu, and set your Duration to how many noon-noon periods you will need the facility for.
<b>Outdoor Pavilion <u>WITH</u> Kitchen</b>	\$525	Includes commercial kitchen in addition to above. At least one adult (who will be in kitchen at all times when in use) <b>must</b> complete GSHNC Kitchen Training and have current Serv Safe certification, or you must hire a GSHNC certified caterer.	

## Self-Facilitated Programs (1.5 hour blocks from 9am-9pm)

Name	Price	Notes	How to Reserve
<b>Amphitheater</b>	\$180 /block	Stage, fire pit, concrete stadium seating for ~150, and ground seating for 300. Easy access to wishboat launching area and boardwalk – book 'Wishboats' for your group for a great evening ceremony. No power or water. Includes access to Eloo bathroom.	<p>Follow the rental directions from the first page, but select <b>'Program Areas (No Facilitator Needed)'</b> from the drop-down menu.</p> <p>Select a Date, Start Time, and Duration (in 1.5-hour blocks), and the system will show you what is available.</p> <p><b>PLEASE NOTE:</b> these activities are <b>self-led</b>. No camp staff will be provided to lead your group through these activities – you will need to lead them yourself. Many kits have directions for use, but some, like the Sports Fields, are unstructured.</p> <p>Specific details about what your group will need to bring will be provided by your on-site contact prior to your rental.</p>
<b>Chapel in the Woods</b>	\$45 /block	Covered shelter with picnic tables and fireplace. A shared area for all rentals, you can reserve it for your exclusive use for an event or ceremony. Includes access to port-a-potty(s) or bathroom, depending on group size, special needs, and other rentals.	
<b>Sports Fields</b>	FREE	Communal fields with sports and games equipment available – see map for field types, and contact for more details if needed.	
<b>Tarheelia Fire Circle</b>	\$75 /block	Large group fire circle with bench seating for ~100 people. Must be reserved to be utilized by a group. Includes access to either port-a-potty(s) or single bathroom, depending on group size, special needs, and other rentals.	
<b>Waterfront Beach</b>	\$75 /block	<b>Does not including boating or swimming activities.</b> Comes with access to covered picnic shelter, portable campfire bowl, and Eloo bathroom at waterfront beach area. Book 'Wishboats' for your group for a great evening ceremony!	
<b>Wishboats</b>	\$3 /person	<b>This is an add-on for those renting Waterfront Beach or Amphitheater only.</b> One eco-friendly biodegradable wishboat provided per person. No training is needed to launch these wishboats, and they do not need to be collected after launch.	
<b>Bat Box</b>	\$45 /block	Facilitator guide and supplies for three activities to learn about bats, how they see, and how we can help them. <b>Must bring own glue.</b>	
<b>Geocaching</b>	\$45 /block	How-to guide and 10 GPS units pre-programmed with a round-the-camp scavenger hunt. Length depends on group's walking speed – book two activity blocks back to back if your group would like to take a more leisurely pace.	
<b>Insectopia</b>	\$45 /block	Facilitator guide and supplies for activities to teach your group about insects. Contact your on-site staff to set up a time for microscope usage with this activity. <b>Must bring own craft materials.</b>	
<b>It's for the Birds</b>	\$45 /block	Facilitator guide, bird identifying books, binoculars, and magnifying glasses to help you and your group discover and learn about birds around camp.	
<b>Night Discovery</b>	\$45 /block	Facilitator guide, constellation guides, and two nightvision scopes for activities exploring night vision and star gazing. <b>Must bring own batteries.</b>	
<b>Pollinators</b>	\$45 /block	Facilitator guide, games, and garden stakes for decorating as group learns about pollinators and how to attract them. <b>Must bring own art supplies.</b>	
<b>Scat and Tracks</b>	\$45 /block	Facilitator guide, molds of various scat and animal tracks, and activity supplies to learn to identify them in the wild. <b>Must bring own paper and colored pencils.</b>	
<b>Tree Wonders</b>	\$45 /block	Facilitator guide, tree info guides, plant examples, and activities to identify trees and learn how they grow. <b>Must bring own potting supplies.</b>	
<b>WOWW: Wonders of Water and Wildlife + Stream Ecology</b>	\$45 /block	Badge and Journey connections for all age levels for the activities "Looking through a Microscope" and "Testing the Waters." Contact on-site staff to set up a time for microscope usage. This is a longer activity set – it is recommended that you book it for <b>at least 3 hours</b> (or two activity blocks back-to-back).	

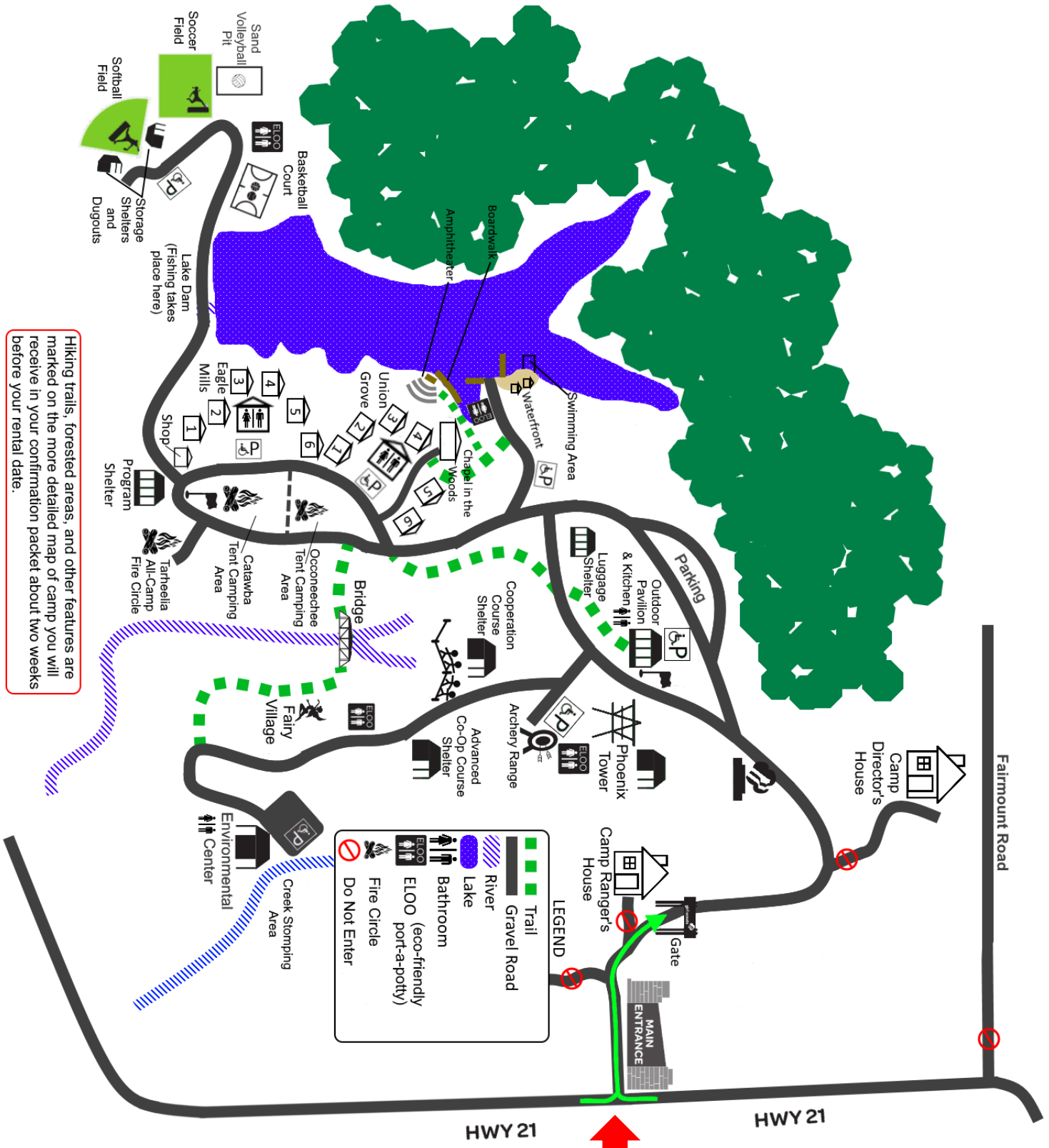

<b>Archery</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 25	\$60 /block	+\$3 /person*	<b>All</b> Daisies, and any Brownies who cannot use regular bows, will use lightweight safety bows and arrows.	Follow the rental directions from the first page, but select <b>'Program Areas (Facilitated)'</b> from the drop-down menu.  Select a Date, Start Time, and Duration (these are in 1.5-hour blocks), and the system will show you what is available. <b>Advanced Co-Op Course and Phoenix Tower must be booked in 2-block durations only.</b>  For each area, you will need to select whether you will be providing your own currently certified facilitator, or if you need to hire a facilitator.
<b>Sling Shots</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 25	\$60 /block	+\$3 /person*	Held at Archery range if available. If range in use, portable range equipment can be used at approved locations.	
<b>Co-Op Games</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 25	\$60 /block	+\$3 /person*	Teambuilding field games, good for medium-to-large groups.	
<b>Co-Op Course</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 25	\$60 /block	+\$3 /person*	ALWAYS begins with ground activities. Group will progress to elements at facilitator's discretion - this varies group by group. May book two sessions back-to-back if interested in tackling more elements after ground activities.	
<b>Advanced Co-Op Course</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 16	\$120 /double block	+\$10 /person*	3 hour session Begins with ground activities, and progresses through several of the challenges in the Co-Op Course, including some with a Group Rescue theme. Progression is at the facilitator's discretion, and varies group by group.	
<b>Phoenix Tower</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 25	\$120 /double block	+\$10 /person*	3 hour session More of an individual activity, the Phoenix Tower emphasizes challenge-by-choice and encourages participants to cheer each other on as they tackle the tower on their own.	
<b>Creek Stomping</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 20	\$60 /block	+\$3 /person*	Water cannot be deeper than knee-high. One adult per 10 participants must complete on-site Watcher orientation.	<sup>†</sup> If you have fewer than the minimum number of participants, you can still book, but you will have to pay for the minimum number if you are hiring a facilitator.
<b>Fishing</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 10	\$60 /block	+\$2 /person*	Fishing will take place at the Dam. One adult from group must complete on-site Watcher orientation. Bait is only provided for groups paying the facilitator fee.	
<b>Lake Swimming</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 20	\$60 /block	+\$3 /person*	Participants must undergo swim check or be limited in swimming area. One adult per 10 participants must complete on-site Watcher orientation.	<b>Only one Lake activity can be booked at a time.</b>  To book multiple Lake activities concurrently, please call 704-731-6500 to see if we can cover multiple areas. You can also book multiple areas if you are providing your own facilitator(s).  *Groups providing own facilitator (see note below table) do NOT need to pay Facilitator Fee cost, only Site Fee.  Groups providing their own facilitator can also reserve activities after the 6-week deadline. Call 704-731-6500 to check availability and book via phone.
<b>Canoeing</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 12	\$60 /block	+\$3 /person*	An adult must paddle each boat that has Daisies. One adult from group must complete on-site Watcher orientation.	
<b>Corcl Boating</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 12	\$60 /block	+\$5 /person*	Participants are likely to get wet, head to toe. One adult from group must complete on-site Watcher orientation.	
<b>Kayaking</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 10	\$60 /block	+\$4 /person*	One adult from group must complete on-site Watcher orientation.	
<b>Stand-Up Paddle-boarding</b>	Min: 8 <sup>†</sup> Max: 10	\$60 /block	+\$5 /person*	Participants are likely to get wet, head to toe. One adult from group must complete on-site Watcher orientation.
