Animal Habitat Field Trip

Grades: 4-5 **Cost:** \$25 **Weeks:** 1, 2

Conflicts: *Mountain Ziplining and Whitewater Rafting (1), Hit the Trails (2)*

On this trip you will discover what animals live in North Carolina and where, investigate an animal habitat, and learn what animals need to survive in order to create the proper habitat for a given animal through hands-on animal encounters. Juniors attending this program will earn the Animal Habitats badge!

Animal Helper Field Trip

Grades: 6-8 **Cost:** \$25 **Weeks:** 4, 5

Conflicts: *Mountain Ziplining & Whitewater Rafting (4), Llama Trek (5)*

On this trip you will learn about animals in history, and experience how animals help people through hands-on time with animals and interactive games. Cadettes attending this program will earn the Animal Helper badge!

Cadette Vet Tech

Grades: 6-8 **Cost:** \$25 **Weeks:** 1, 2

Conflicts: *Horseback Trail Ride A (All), Mountain Ziplining & Whitewater Rafting (1), Hit the Trails (2)*

Want to learn what it takes to be a vet? You'll participate in mock clinics where you will look at x-rays to determine what an animal may have eaten, perform a mock spay on a stuffed animal, use a stethoscope to listen to an animal's heartbeat, learn to give injections by practicing on a banana, and participate in scenarios to see what you would do if you were the vet.

Canoe River Trip

Grades: 4-9 **Cost:** \$50 **Weeks:** 1, 2, 4, 5

Conflicts: *Pottery Class (All)*

Girls will spend the afternoon canoeing down the Yadkin River! Campers must have basic swimming skills.

Hit the Trails

Grades: 6-9 **Cost:** \$175 **Weeks:** 2

Conflicts: *Animal Habitat Field Trip, Horseback Trail Ride A, Cadette Vet Tech*

This two-day overnight mountain adventure will send you a few hours north of camp to enjoy a horseback trail ride and a mountain bike trip down the Virginia Creeper trail!

Horseback Trail Ride A

Grades: 4-9 **Cost:** \$75 **Weeks:** 1, 2, 4, 5

Conflicts: *Cadette Vet Tech (1, 2), Mountain Ziplining and Whitewater Rafting (1, 4), Hit the Trails (2), Junior Vet Tech (4, 5), Llama Trek (5)*

Girls will head out on horseback and enjoy a beautiful ride on a mountain trail. No previous horseback riding experience is required. Campers must weigh less than 250 lbs.

Horseback Trail Ride B

Grades: 4-9 **Cost:** \$75 **Weeks:** 1, 2, 4, 5

Conflicts: *Zipline Adventure (All)*

Girls will head out on horseback and enjoy a beautiful ride on a mountain trail. No previous horseback riding experience is required. Campers must weigh less than 250 lbs.

Junior Vet Tech

Grades: 4-5 **Cost:** \$25 **Weeks:** 4, 5

Conflicts: *Horseback Trail Ride A (All), Mountain Ziplining and Whitewater Rafting (4), Llama Trek (5)*

Llama Trek

Grades: 6-9 **Cost:** \$175 **Weeks:** 5

Conflicts: *Animal Helper Field Trip, Horseback Trail Ride A, Junior Vet Tech*

Discover the wonders of nature as you hike through the forest with your new llama friend. Enjoy backpacking, but let the llama carry some of the load! You'll spend time getting to know your llama before heading out on the trail with them for an overnight adventure.

Mountain Ziplining and Whitewater Rafting

Grades: 6-9 **Cost:** \$175 **Weeks:** 1, 4

Conflicts: *Horseback Trail Ride A (All), Animal Habitat Field Trip (1), Cadette Vet Tech (1), Animal Helper Field Trip (4), Junior Vet Tech (4)*

Campers will head out for an overnight trip at the Nantahala Gorge to enjoy an evening on the first canopy tour in the Nantahala Gorge Region. This full course takes you deep in the woods and high in the treetops, with spectacular views of Fontana Lake and the Nantahala Gorge. In the morning, campers will enjoy eight miles of crystal clear water and constant waves that make the Nantahala River a delight. This 3-hour trip through class I and II rapids ends with Nantahala Falls, a thrilling class III drop! Campers must be rising 6th graders or older, between 60 and 250 lbs, and have basic swimming skills.

Pottery Class

Grades: 4-9 **Cost:** \$50 **Weeks:** 1, 2, 4, 5

Conflicts: *Canoe River Trip (All)*

Girls will visit a local pottery studio and get creative with clay! Their creation will be fired in a kiln so they will have an amazing keepsake from their week at camp.

River Tubing Trip

Grades: 4-9 **Cost:** \$35 **Weeks:** 1, 2, 4, 5

Conflicts: *None!*

Girls will spend a relaxing afternoon tubing down the Yadkin River. Campers must have basic swimming skills.

Zipline Adventure

Grades: 4-9 **Cost:** \$100 **Weeks:** 1, 2, 4, 5

Conflicts: *Horseback Trail Ride B*

What makes this experience unique? Tree-trekking, skywalking, and cargo climbing all in one adventure, PLUS 5 interconnected zips ending in a 520' long megazip! Campers must weigh less than 250 lbs.
