Once you have done so, continue adding to your reservation until you’re set. Press ‘Checkout’ to complete your rental info and pay!</p>

Facilitator will need to schedule a skills check with Council staff if they have not completed one within the last year.</p> <p><b>All</b> K-1<sup>st</sup> Graders, and any 2<sup>nd</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Graders who cannot use regular bows, will use lightweight safety bows and arrows.</p>	<p>Follow the previous directions, but select <b>‘Program Areas.’</b></p> <p>Select a Date, Start Time, and Duration (these are in 1.5-hour blocks), and the system will show you what is available.</p>
Games Field	--	\$30	Large open area next to Pavilion. A <u>communal use area</u> , you can reserve it for your exclusive use if you need to make sure you have it for an event or activity. Field is unavailable when Archery has been rented.	<p>Archery must be booked by <b>no later than two weeks before your rental</b>. If it is after that, call 704-731-6500 to check availability.</p>

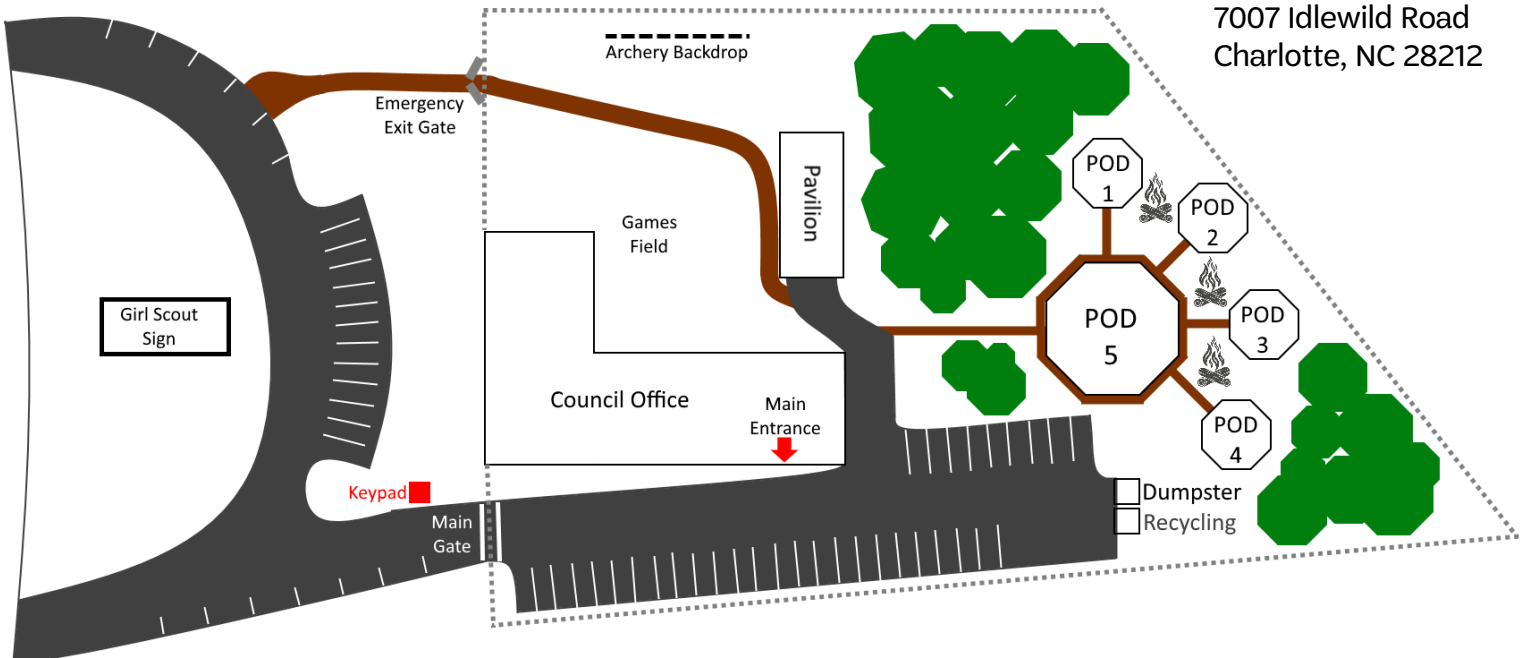
## Day Use Only Rental (8am – 5pm)

Pavilion	\$70	Open pavilion with rolling shutter doors, picnic tables, lights, and electricity. Includes access to bathrooms at the back of the Council office, and to communal fire rings and fields. <b>Please note</b> , if another rental group has reserved Archery or the Games Field area, they will have primary access to the field next to the Pavilion! If you are planning to use the field for a specific activity during your rental period, you may want to reserve it as well.	Follow the rental directions from the first page, but select <b>'Day Use Only'</b> from the drop-down menu, and set your Duration to how many days you need the facility for.
