



Volunteer of Excellence Award for Service to Girls

The Volunteer of Excellence Award may be earned twice – once for service directly to girls and once for working with adults.

Adults receiving this award:

- Must be an active, registered adult member
- Must have successfully completed a term of service and all requirements, including appropriate training, for the position
- Must meet the criteria for the award

This award requires:

- A Nomination
- 1 Letter of Endorsement

Process: Nominator will complete the nomination form and secure the endorsement letter and submit both parts to the Service Unit Adult Awards Coordinator by March 15. The Service Unit Awards Committee will review all nominations and determine who receives the award.

Criteria: The volunteer's contribution must go beyond the expectations of the position in delivering the Girl Scout Leadership Experience to girls using the National Program Portfolio.
