• Applicants must be a registered member of Girl Scouts of Hornets Nest Council.

Applicants will be notified via email regarding scholarship award decisions.

- Girl Scots who are awarded travel scholarship funds are expected to share with their experience with others by: (1) Presenting at council-sponsored events, and (2) Submitting photos and a brief overview essay for use in travel promotions.
- Photos and the essay are due no later than two weeks following the completion of travel.
- Please note that funding is limited, and not all applicants are guaranteed a scholarship. Up to five (5) travel scholarships of \$800
 each will be awarded. Parental involvement with Girl Scouts Hornets' Nest Council will have no impact on award decisions or
 funding amounts.
- Each Girl Scout may receive funding for one travel experience per fiscal year (January-December)
- Applicants must have sold a minimum of 48 boxes of cookies and one (1) Fall Product unit within the past year, or be actively
 participating in the current travel scholarship cycle.
